

Trend and steps in improving HPV vaccination coverage



HPV Vaccine Coverage S1:2024

	9year females	9 year males

Cameroon	22%	15%

- O 2020: Onset of HPV vaccination (9-year females)
 - Performance remained low (dose 1:<20%, dose 2:6%)
 - 2022: Single dose protocol & vaccinating females & males 9 years old (Cameroon's NITAG, 2022)
- O Strengthen collaboration and communication
 - Min. Basic Education, OBS/Gyns, Schools, religious groups, CSO, & interpersonal in communities
- O 2023: Gender neutral, integration in all RI activities and PIRI
 - 2023 coverage*3: females 66% and males 34%

2024

- O Lower coverage (challenge of routine immunization)
- O Strategies
 - Vaccination of adolescents 9-15yrs living with HIV
 - Integrate in Big Catchup
 - MAC request being finalized
 - Target 10 to 18yr
 - Three-phase campaign approach in 3 yrs
