> Implementation Strategy

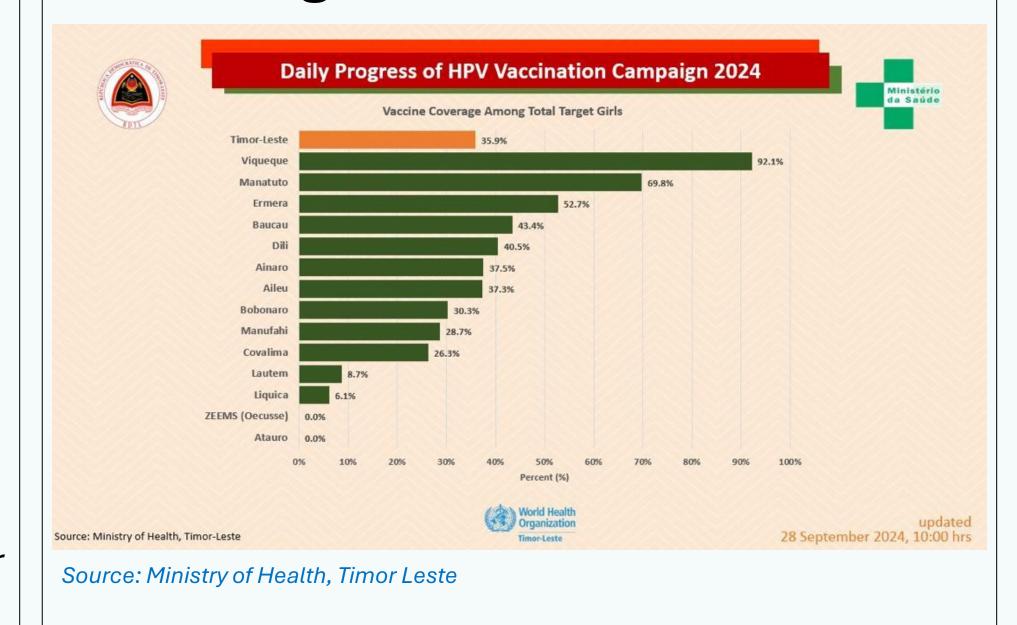
- School-based outreach

 - Announcement through radio, church, TV, Social media
 - Vehicle miking announcement, door-to-door information sharing with the support from Mother Support Groups

- The involvement of **Mother Support Groups** in enumeration non-school girls because it makes the enumeration process completed faster.
- Local Champions: Engage faith-based organizations, political leaders, community leaders, health workers, parents and teachers to advocate for HPV vaccination, increasing trust and acceptance.

>>> Barriers

- Logistical barrier having limited transportation to hard-to-reach areas can limit the campaign's scope and reach.
- **Geographic Barriers:** Remote communities may have limited access to healthcare services, making it challenging to reach all populations.

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
