» Programme Status

- Nationwide introduction into routine immunization program
- Year of Introduction: October 2023
- Developed a guideline for HPV vaccine introduction into the routine immunization program

» Dosing Schedule

- Vaccine product: Cervarix (2vHPV)
- Number of Doses: 1-dose
- Target Cohort: 9-year-old girls

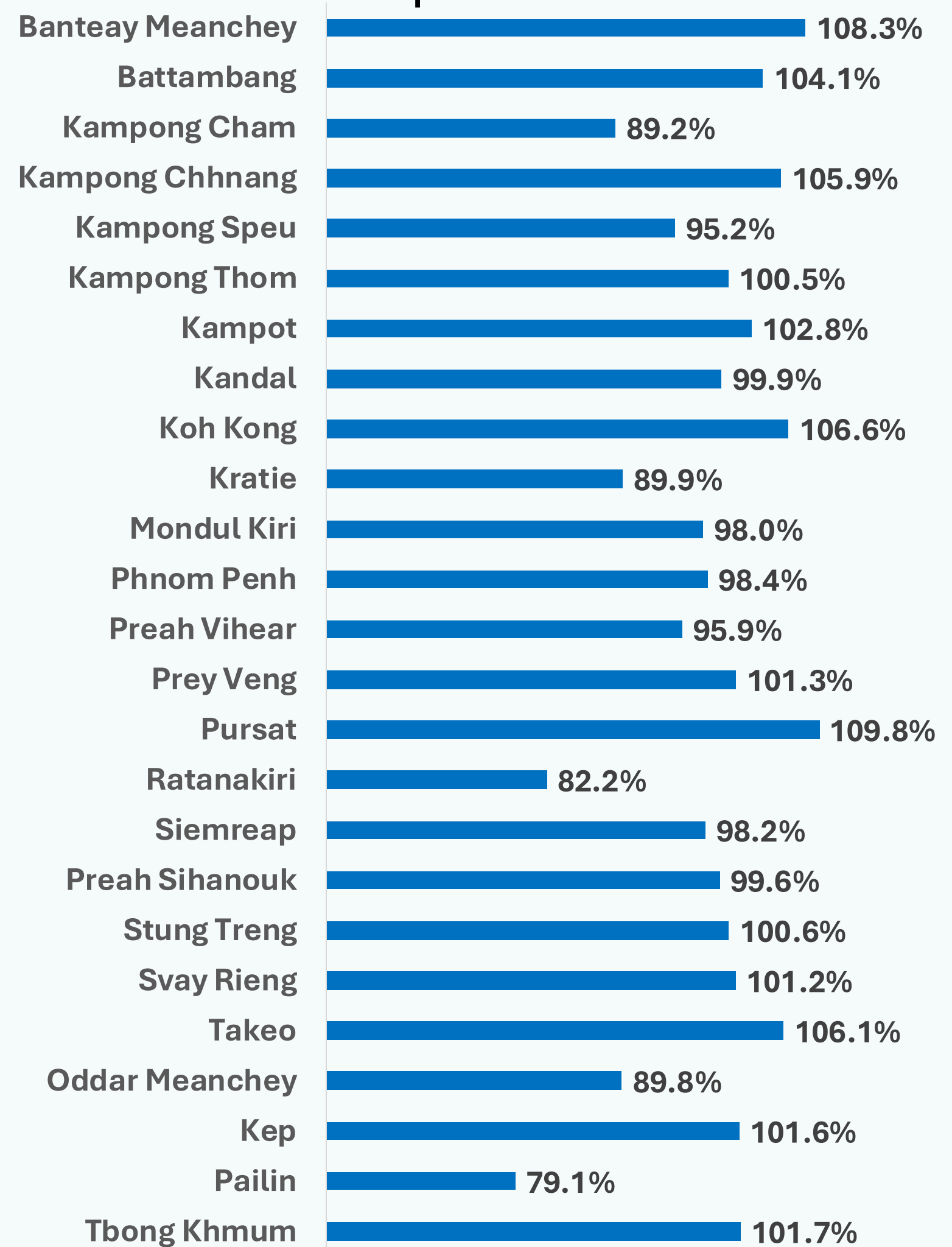
» Service Delivery Strategy

- School-based and community outreach, supported by fixed site
- Pre-registration of girls at school and community to estimate the volume of the target population, and develop micro-plans at service delivery points across the country

» Coverage

- National coverage rate: >99% (2023)
Used pre-registration number as a denominator

- Variations at 25 provinces: 79~109%



» Highlight of the HPV vaccination program

- High coverage rate at national level: >99%
- Strong sectoral coordination (Health & Education) at national and provincial levels
- Comprehensively reaching girls at schools and communities through pre-registration
- Target confusion in introduction year caused by age-based eligibility
- 36% operational districts (37/103) reported zero out-of-school (OOS) girls during pre-registration period

» Facilitators

- High acceptance and demand
- Strong ministerial level coordination
- Effective communication channels: radio, televised interviews, messengers
- Strong micro-plans at schools

» Barriers

- Delayed introduction timeline
- Limited local coordination at peripheral levels for communication and outreach
- Misunderstanding of out-of-school, although dropout exists
